From the Commodore's Deck

Hello RVMYC'ers,

Well reports couldn't be more stark. In preparing for this report, I reviewed my last one to you about the fantastic experiences we had over the Williamstown Seaport Festival week end. Loads of activity, fun and comraderie. All held in person and with much mirth. For now however we must make sacrifices so as to ensure the health and safety of all. It is lengthy and it is sometimes tedious but it is really the only effective way we can put this behind us. So I'll just address a few pertinent issues with you in relation to club operations for the near future.

As previously announced the Clubhouse & BBQ area closed in accordance with government policy. The yard remains operational and we ask that users maintain the prescribed distancing and hygiene procedures. The office is being staffed between 10am and 3pm. It is not open for personal visitations so we ask that any business or queries be directed via telephone or email.

The committee is still engaged in pursuing club matters and held it's usual monthly meeting via Zoom last Tuesday which proved most successful. Matters that will be of interest to you that were dealt with included investigating the club's options with our bank, the Job

Keeper Scheme as well as Parks Victoria who are offering stays on rent for tenants such as us. The committee also determined that the Duty officer role on weekends be postponed for the lock down period and will be reviewed when recreational boating restrictions are lifted. The upcoming AGM was also discussed in relation to our options on how it could be done. We'll keep you posted on that.

The Mariners have organised a virtual Wine Tasting for the 8th May. A pack of 4 wines have been selected and can be picked up from the club with a menu of suggested food accompaniments for you to prepare, then we will all get on Zoom and Andrew Nankervis from Unique Wines can take us through the wines. You don't have to drink all the wines in the one sitting, although if you're like me, wine o'clock seems to be arriving earlier each day!!

The club also commenced offering meals which are prepared fresh and frozen for your convenience, as well as wine & beverage a few weeks ago. These have proved to be very popular and we will continue to do so for as long as they are popular. Chef Glen has been preparing some very tasty treats which can be easily purchased along with the wine & beverage

via the club portal. We're sitting on a few kegs of beer which we'd like to move so it is being offered by the litre at reduced prices and is a great deal for members.

At time of writing there have been murmurings of easing of restrictions. Whilst details are not clear presently, there's no doubt that we probably won't be going straight back to mass gatherings which will also probably impose restrictions such as persons per square metre and the like. It is something to look forward to and rest assured we'll do whatever we can to get back open as soon as is permissible.

I'd just like to close this report by thanking you, our wonderful members for your fantastic support of the club, the committee for their selfless work and our loyal and dedicated staff. You all truly have the club at heart and that's what makes the RVMYC so great.




